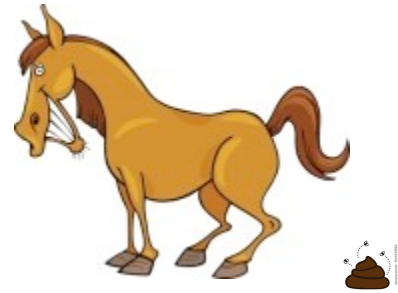


PONY POOP ROUND-UP

Pony Poop Round-Up is a game that pits your luck against the gastronomical actions of a horse. The horse will do “what comes naturally” on our field. You purchase deeds of land for \$2/each and if the horse dumps on your land, you win! Proceeds from the game will be used to pay for fun events like Western Night and the Sock Hop! GENERAL RULES

- Each Pony Poop Deed is sold at \$2.00 each. Multiple deeds may be purchased.
- Each Deed represents a 2-foot square parcel on the field at Gold Rush.
- Those purchasing deeds in person may select the location of the land they choose. Other purchases (dropped off Deeds For Sale) will be drawn at random from the remaining plots available.
- There are 1014 deeds available for purchase.
- If your deeded square receives a pony deposit – YOU ARE THE WINNER!
- The horse will be released upon arrival on Friday, September 15th.
- The horse will be walked to the field and walked on a loose lead around the field. The lead is for safety reasons.
- If the horse poops in one or more deeds, the deeded square with the largest portion of the poop will be declared the winner.
- If the poop portions are too close to determine a winner, the prize will be split equally between the shared square deed holders.
- If the horse poops on an un-deeded square, the closest deeded square will be declared the winner.
- If the horse poops on the intersection of 4 squares, the prize is split 4 ways evenly among the 4 owners.
- Judges will watch the horse and determine the location of the “deposit”.
- In the event a deposit has not been made by 6:45 pm, a Horse Poop Round-Up Judge will draw from all entries for the winning deed.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- Winner does not need to be present to win.
- Checks should be made payable to G.R.E.A.T. and can be returned to school with your student, or placed in the PTO mailbox in the front office.
- Deadline to purchase deeds is Friday, September 15th at 8:30 a.m., or until the deeds are sold out.
